

Northwest Compass provides care coordination, counseling and assistance to people experiencing food and housing instability or homelessness by connecting them to housing options, resources and various supportive services. The Housing Program consists of Street Outreach, Transitional Living program, Permanent Supportive Housing Program, Youth Housing Demonstration Project and Rapid Rehousing for DV victims.

Housing counseling and homeless diversion and prevention, and immediate short-term assistance to prevent individuals and families at risk of becoming homeless for the first time or to assist them to exit homelessness. Most of the programs include assessment, wraparound services and care coordination in order to provide the needed assistance and support, so people can make better informed choices and build a foundation toward creating a stable and sustainable future.
